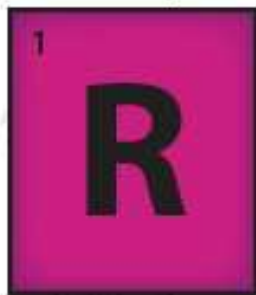
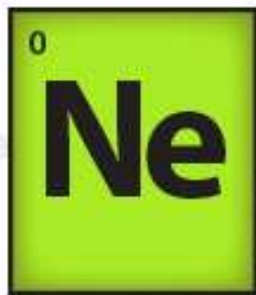
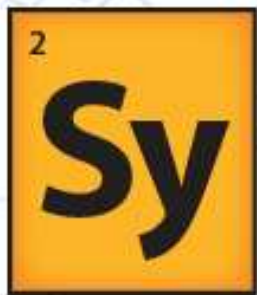


The Science of **Small Groups** This Year at **Synergy**

I'll Pray For You... For Real

How can a small group leader truly have the greatest impact possible on the people in his or her group? How do leaders develop a deeply compassionate heart for the people they lead? This session will investigate the simple yet overlooked act of prayer available to every believer. In addition, one will learn of filters that can be used to effectively practice intercessory prayer. We know to abide in Christ for ourselves. Come and see how to abide in Christ for others.

Spiritual Practices for Groups (PM only)

We all want greater intimacy & connection with God. And in our groups we want to see lives transformed. But when it comes to a greater connection with God or becoming more like Jesus, many people wonder if change is even possible. For most: the problem is not that we are unwilling to change, or don't have the desire to, but simply: we have never been shown how. In this class we will explore the habits and practices found in Scripture and specifically in the life and teachings of Jesus and learn how God uses these practices in our lives to help us be in His presence more regularly, and therefore become more like Christ.
